


Children Served by Setting

A total of 9,674 children are served by sites participating in QCC.


Overall Child Characteristics and Services Provided



Children's Races and Ethnicities




QCC Tier Rating Distribution

Tier ratings help providers identify areas for improvement and find ways to sustain success.


Language Spoken with Children
